Prerequisites for course attendance are:

- Current SASS member
- ROII certification (this may be waived if you are a certified RO in another shooting discipline) or on a case by case basis if you do not have an ROII
- Complete familiarization with the SASS WB Handbook
- Understanding of the function and operation of all SASS WB legal firearms

Fulfilling the above prerequisites will greatly enhance each participant's successful completion of the course and allow for continuity and consistency of training as well. If you have any questions about the prerequisites, please email Idaho Six Gun Sam for more information (email listed below).

Before attending the WBAS RO certification training, you should:

- Read the Handbook (<http://www.sassnet.com/Downloads/RO/Wild%20Bunch%20Handbook%202013.pdf>)
- Read the Handbook again.
- Preregister for class

What should you bring to class?

- Bring the (ratty, well worn, tattered, highlighted, dog-eared and much READ) WBAS Handbook with you to the training.
- Bring note-taking materials to the training. During the written test, you may refer to your notes. You may NOT use your copy of the WBAS Handbook while taking the test.
- Bring any snacks or drinks you may want.
- Do not bring any firearms or ammunition to the class.

The training course consists of a PowerPoint presentation, a 24 question written test, and a practical test. All the test answers are in the WBAS Handbook, so we emphasize that you read and understand the Handbook before the class. The training will be approximately 6 hours, with a half-hour lunch break and hourly 10-minute breaks. Upon successful completion of the course, you will receive your WBAS RO Pin; be certified in safety aspects and the regular operations of a Wild Bunch Match, familiar with all the rules and regulations of Wild Bunch Shooting; and be certified to be a Timer Operator at a Wild Bunch Match. We hope you will also put to use your new knowledge by being an avid participant in Wild Bunch shooting matches and running the timer as well.
